## Guidelines

- Participation Limit: A student can participate in a maximum of four individual
  events and one group event. Group events are conducted house wise which will
  be intimated later.
- **Event Schedule**: Individual events will commence on **16th June 2025**. Students are encouraged to utilize the summer break for preparation.
- **Competition Timing**: Competitions will be held during class hours and on working Saturdays.
- **Eliminations**: Preliminary rounds will be conducted to shortlist participants for the final rounds.
- **Attendance**: Students who are absent for any event will not be given another opportunity, except in cases where the leave was taken to participate in an interschool competition registered by the school.
- **Registration Process**: A Google Form will be shared in the class group in May for students to register for the events.
